

<u>AS WE GATHER</u> Before kings, authorities, and leaders, we are not to think of ourselves more highly than we ought. Rather, we should posture ourselves to be humble servants, ready to hope for and receive gestures of grace, hospitality, and wisdom. Divine love permeates actions; divine speech evokes truth; divine contentment curbs the propensity toward avarice. Divine forgiveness destroys sin's consequence. Without merit, we receive the grace of Christ – grace that invites us to His feast of forgiveness.

<u>COMMON CUP COMMUNION</u> Today is a quarterly fifth Sunday of the month. This is when it was decided to offer Common Cup at both services. Please read the following from the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod website. If you have questions, please see Senior Pastor Dan Welch, Assistant Pastor Michael Ewert, or Deaconess Megan Polzin.

In its report on <u>Theology and Practice of the Lord's Supper</u>, the Synod's Commission on Theology and Church Relations includes the following question and answer:

<u>Does it matter whether a congregation uses individual glasses or the common cup to distribute the consecrated wine?</u>

"In the absence of a specific Scriptural mandate, either method of distribution, when performed in a reverent manner, is acceptable. Many Christians prefer the use of the common cup because of its symbolism as representative of the oneness of the body of Christ — the church — and because there is reason to believe Christ used this method of distribution. Any decision in this area is to be marked by Christian liberty and charity."

Studies have shown the risk of contracting illness or disease through the use of the common communion cup (properly wiped and handled) is quite small (though not, of course, non-existent). Those who are concerned about this possibility are certainly free to make use of the individual cup option, which is available in nearly all congregations.
