There are free devotional materials available for the edification and strengthening of your faith and spiritual life! There are devotion books for children and adults.

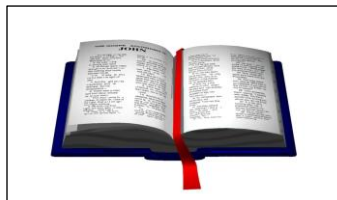

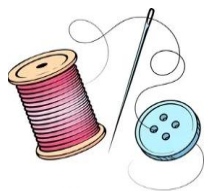
Fellowship Hour Serving Date
